This year marks the 19th anniversary of Vaccination Week in the Americas taking place 24th-30th April, 2021. The theme for this year is “**Vaccines Bring Us Closer**”- to a fairer world, family, friends, and a world without pandemics.

We recognize the progress made through vaccination and we continue to work to sustain the gains. As part of Vaccination Week in the Americas, a mobile vaccination outreach programme has been established to increase access to the COVID-19 vaccine. A “drive-through” will be held at **Penno’s Wharf, St. Georges, on Tuesday April 27, 2021 from 10 am to 2 pm**. Other vaccination sites will be held on Thursday, 29th April and Sunday 2nd May (venues to be announced). This initiative is for families and persons 16 years and older who have not registered for the vaccine, those without access to the internet, those who prefer to register in person and those who require further discussion about the vaccine.
